

# Rice - Average Yield per rai, 1996

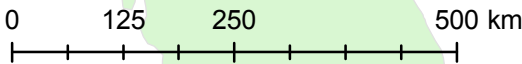
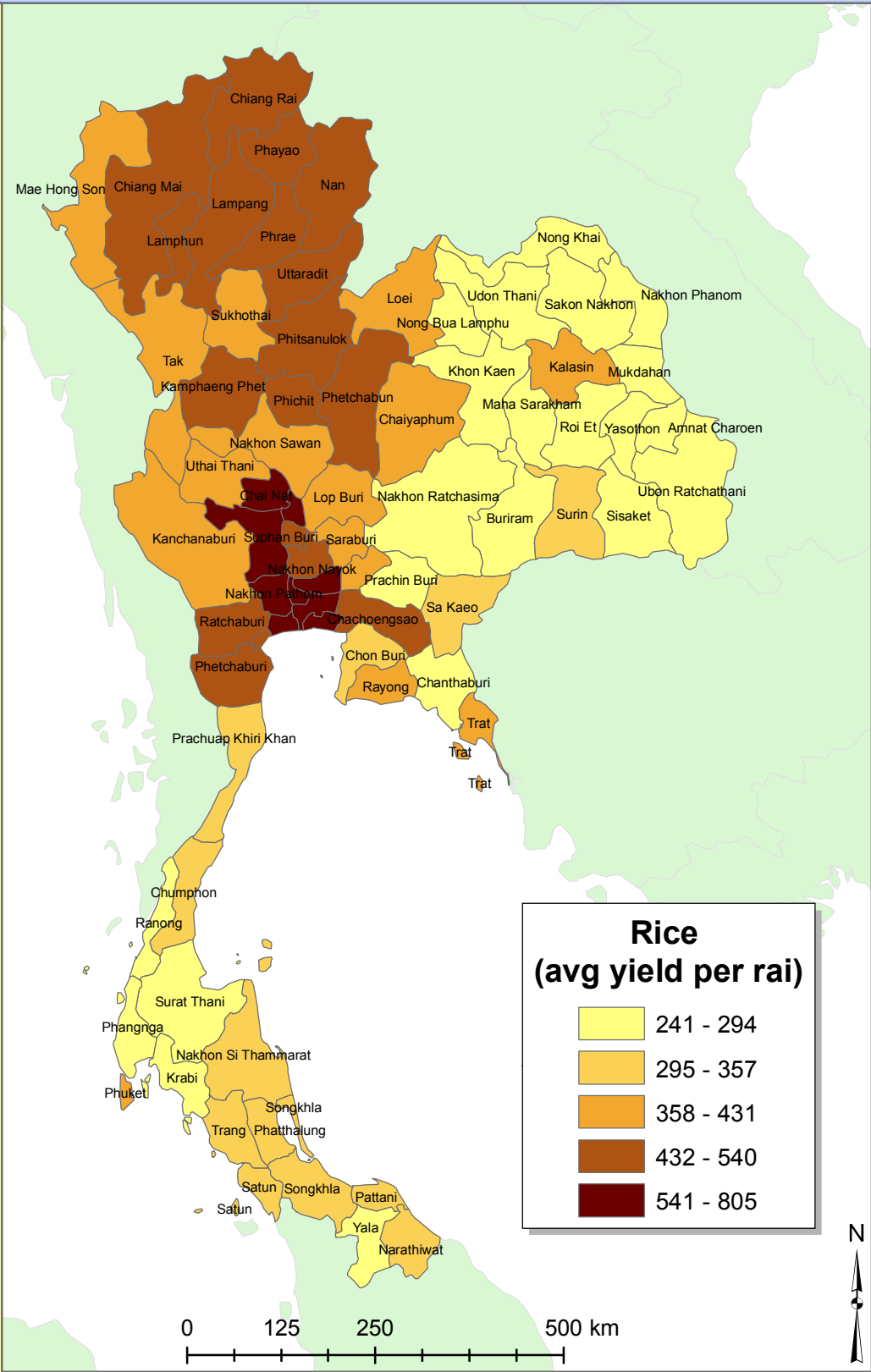
This map illustrates the average yield of rice per rai in 1996 by Changwat. The Changwat that was least productive was Amnat Charoen wich produced about 241 units rice per rai. The Changwat that was most productive was Nonthaburi which harvested about 805 units of rice per rai.

Note: 1 acre is about 2.5 rai  
OR 1 hectare is about 6.25 rai.
