According to the Demographic Health Survey (2002), female migration is highest in rural to rural migration at about 40 percent.

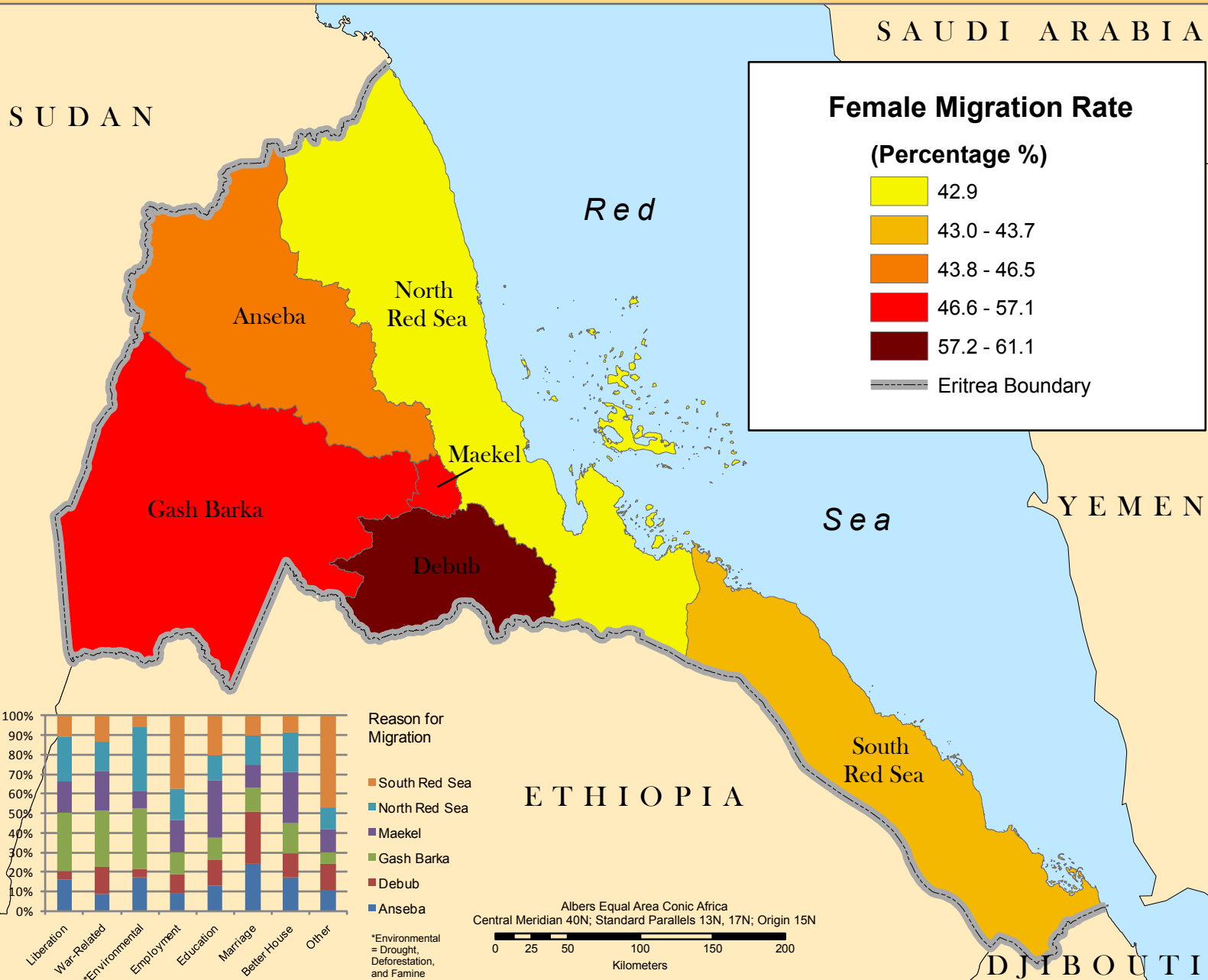
Women migrate for a variety of reasons including for marriage, employment, education, liberation, and a better home.

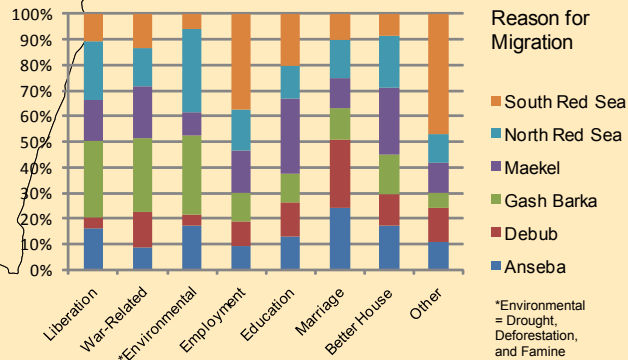
