The crude birth rate is a measure of number of births per 1000 women. It is measure 3 years out from the time of the survey in 2001.

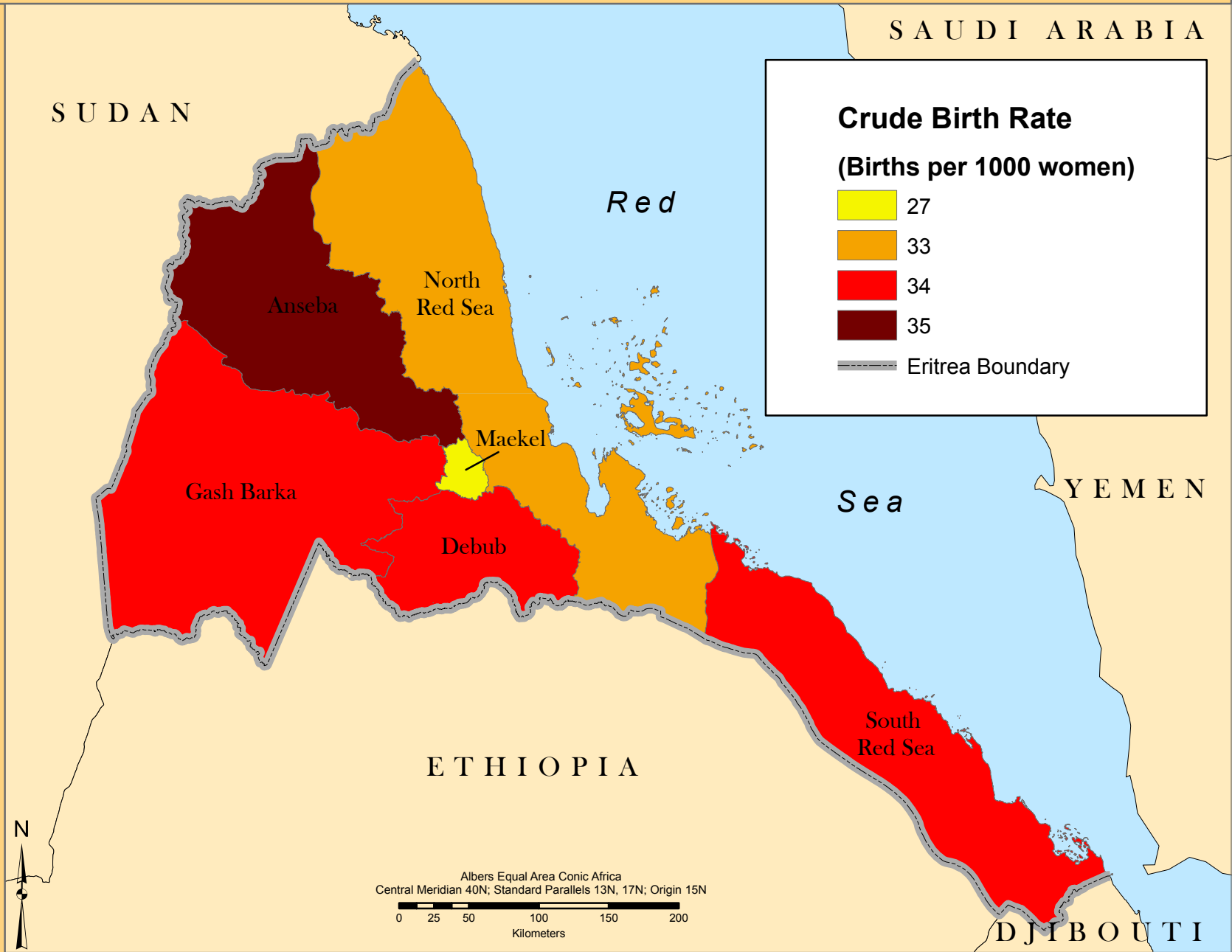
Eritrea's CBR is higher than the world average of 21.1 during this time as calculated by the United Nations.
