There have been many households with displaced persons due to activities of war and conflict.

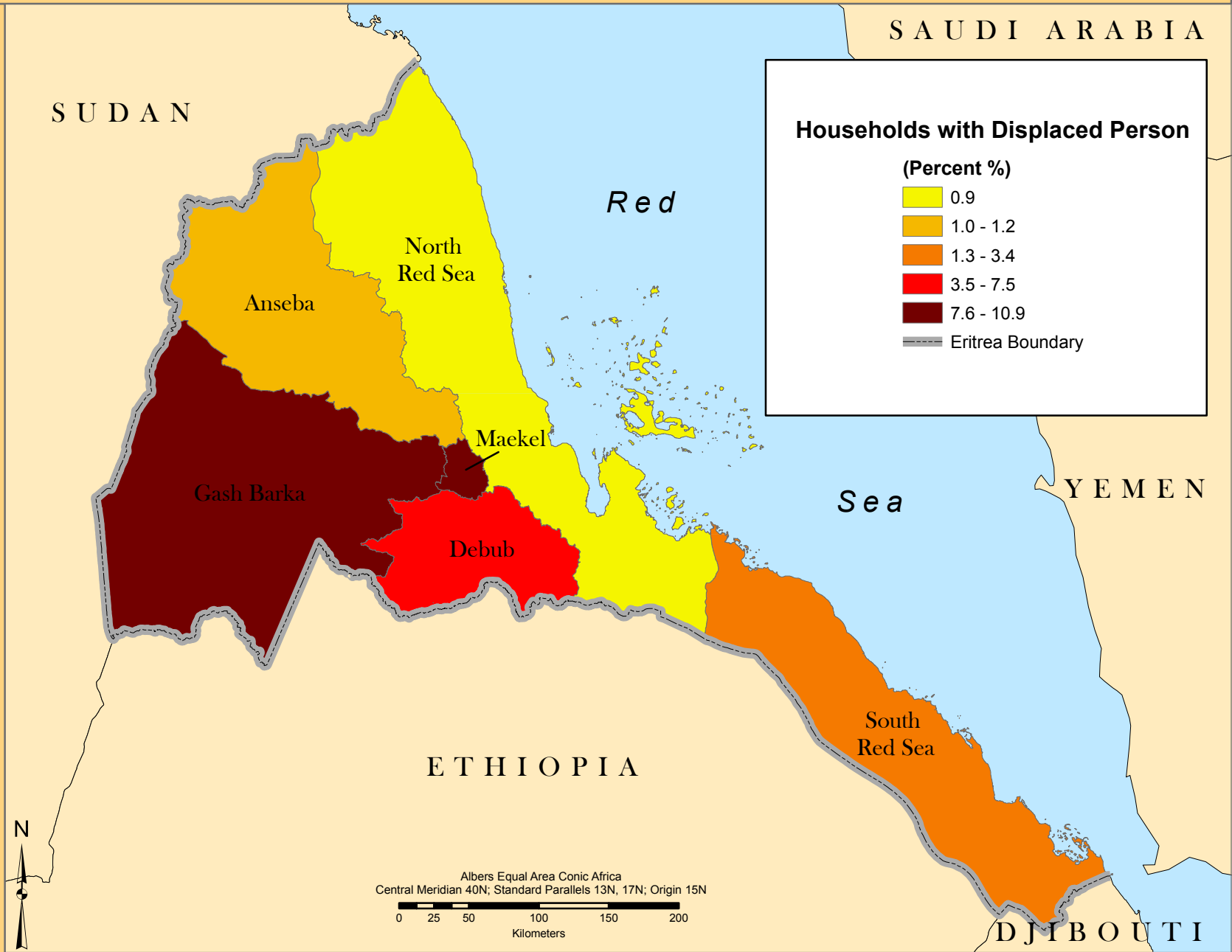
According to the Demographic Health Survey (2002), around 11 percent of the urban households and 4 percent of rural households have at least one displaced person.
