

Average Household Size by Eritrean Zoba

The average household size, according to the Demographic Health Survey (2002) is 4.8 persons. The 2002 number is up from 4.4 in 1995.

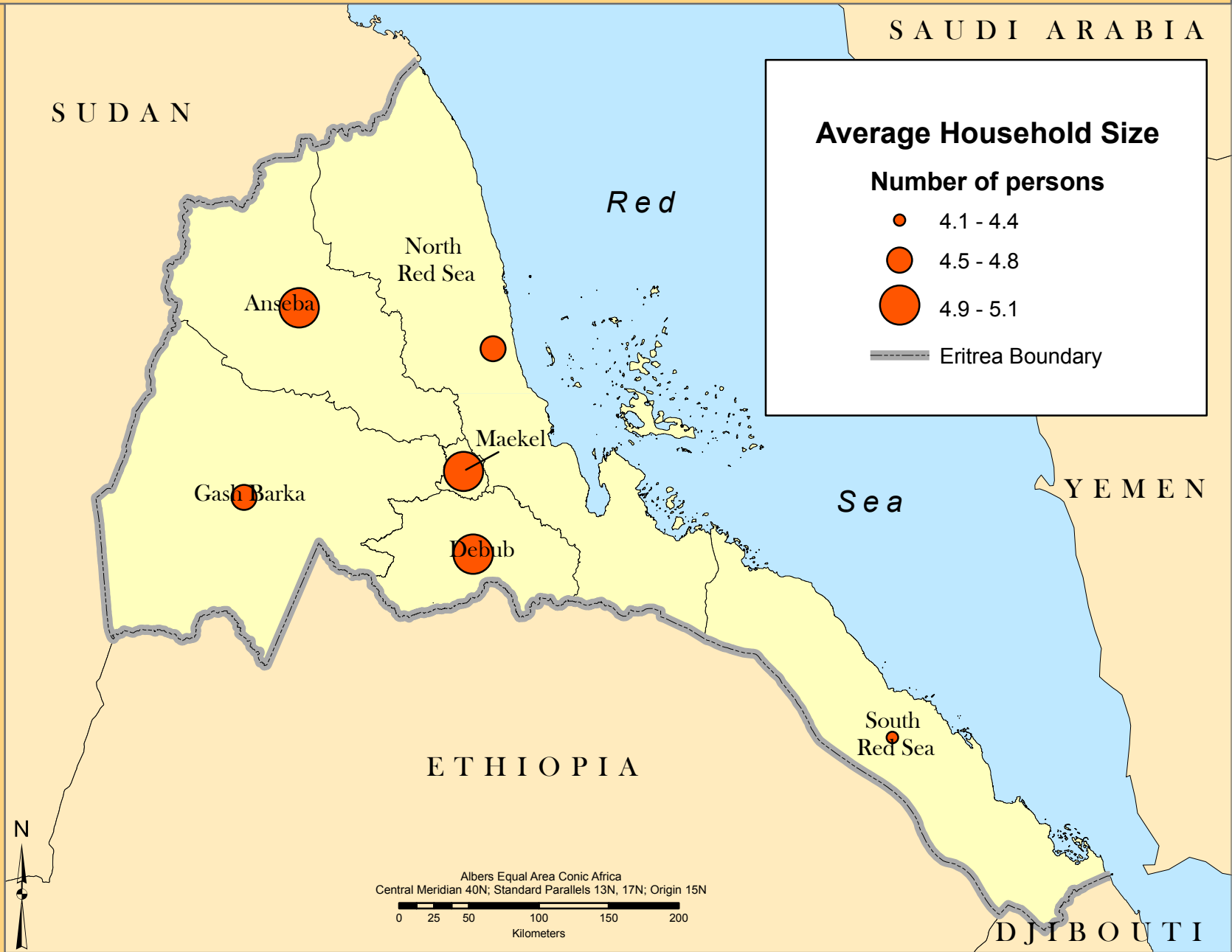
Rural areas have increased slightly more in average since 1995, with a mean of 4.9 compared to urban areas of 4.7.

The South Red Sea zoba has the smallest average household size.
