

# Male as Head of Household (%) by Eritrean Zoba

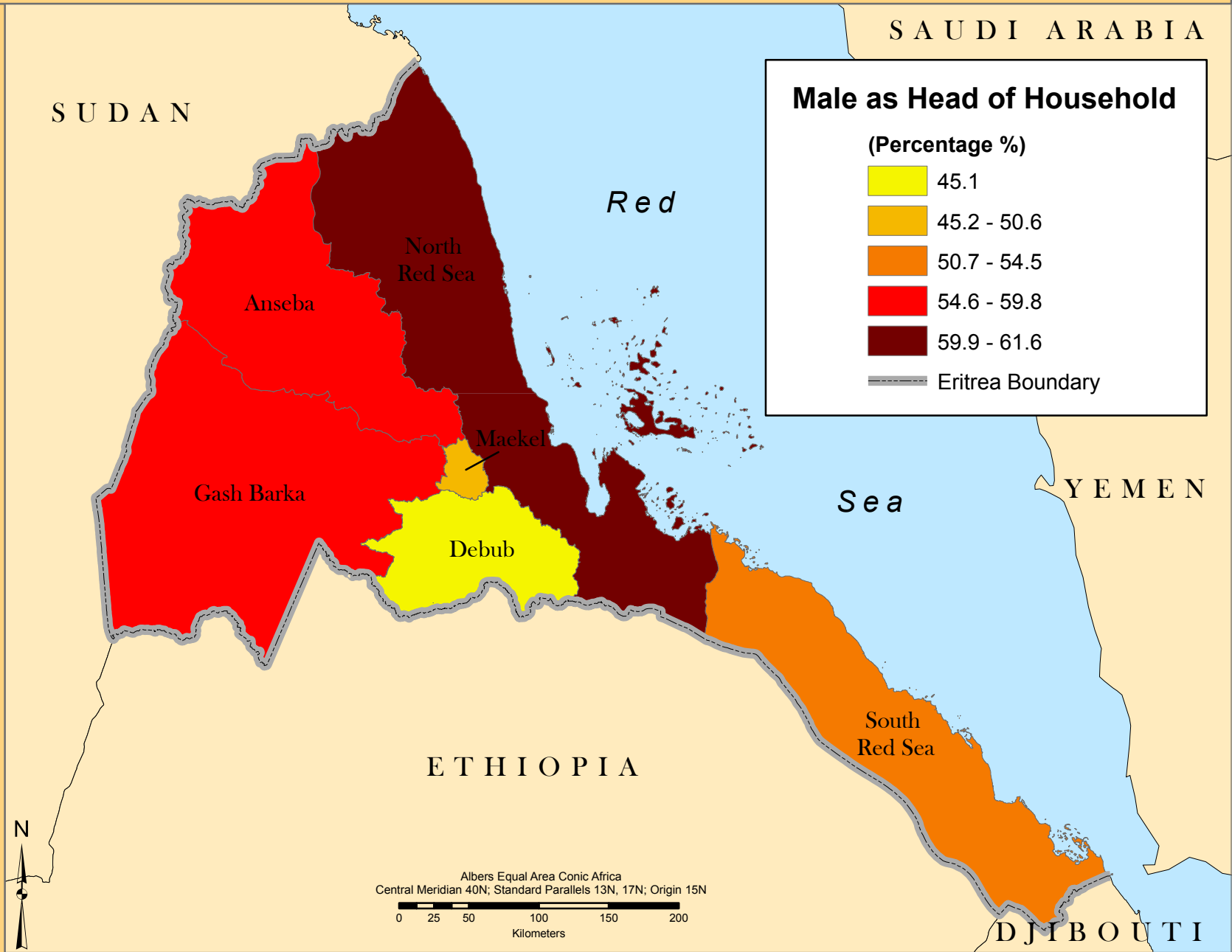
According to the Demographic Health Survey (2002), more than half of the household have a male as head, around 53 percent. The 2002 percentage is significantly lower than the 1995 figure of 69 percent.

Households in Debub feature the fewest heads as males, while the North Red Sea zoba has the highest percentage of male headed households.
