The total number of households in Eritrea in 2001 was 666,619*.

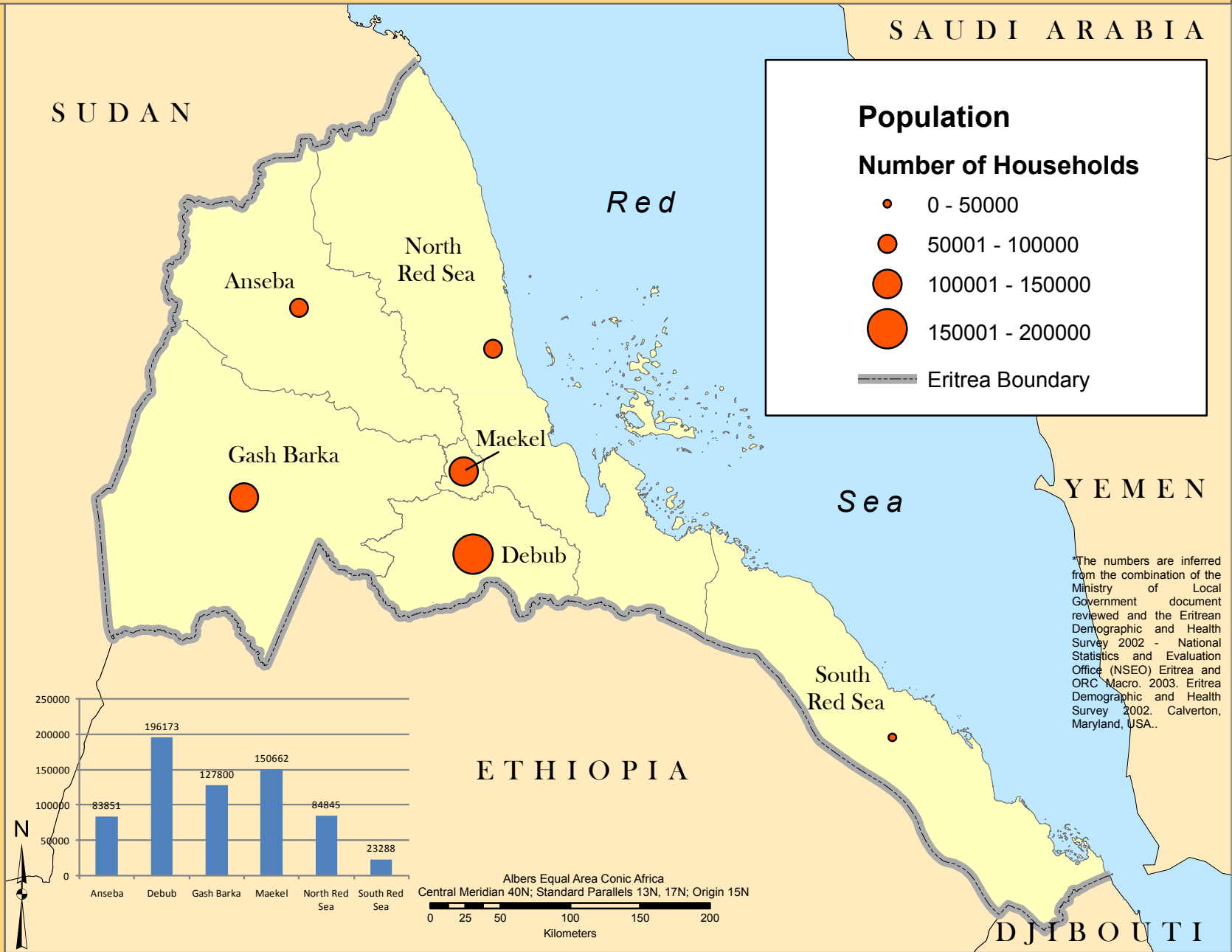
Debub zoba has the most households, while second most are in the capital region of Maekel.

The least populated region and highly arid nomadic area of the South Red Sea (Debabawi Keih Bahri) has the fewest holds with approximately 23,288 households.

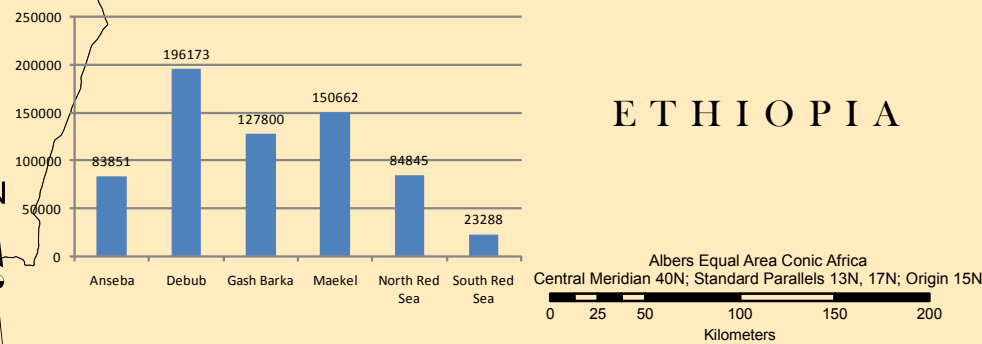
